David Thompson The Kwik Kamp was perfect, except that we rarely stay more than one night in one place. It's living room, being only 3X5' wasn't sufficient and required the Add-a-Room, which added 20-25 minutes to tear down and load.

The new one is an Aspen Classic, which has a 6X6' living room, which gives us room for the camp table, two smaller camp chairs, and the A/C hides under the table. The Aspen is quicker to set up and reload, it's lighter, holds more, but both of our campers handle(d/s) great. We did a 6000 mile trip in September out to Seattle to visit our son, back through Arizona to the Grand Canyon, and home in 12 days. We stayed in the camper 9 of those nights, with one gully-washer in Eureka, MO. Zero issues. The KK was definitely before its time, but the Aspen really upped the ante.
